The Warrant Officer Alfred Wong of 351 (Silver Star) Squadron Memorial Scholarship

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

After WO2 Alfred Wong passed away as the result of an accident in June 2007, his family and friends generously donated funds for a scholarship to be awarded annually in memory of this exceptional young man and outstanding Air Cadet.

The scholarship is to be awarded by competition, on a merit basis, to a serving or retiring Air Cadet who has or will be graduating from Secondary School in the year of application and is enrolling in the first year of a full-time music-related program at an accredited university or college, where the program leads to a degree, diploma, or nationally-recognized qualification. Candidates must, at a minimum, have all of the following attributes:

- Good academic standing at secondary school;
- A good record of community involvement;
- A good record of participation in his / her Squadron activities;
- Completed at least four years service as an Air Cadet.

The application must be supported by the following documents:

- A letter from the applicant (250 – 300 words), describing their interest in a music-related area of study and providing an outline of their career goals;
- A one-page summary of the applicant's Cadet career, extra-curricular School activities, and community activities (point form is fine);
- A letter of recommendation from the applicant's Squadron Commanding Officer;
- A letter of support from the Chairperson of the applicant's Squadron Sponsoring Committee;
- A letter of recommendation from the applicant's School Principal, Music Teacher, or Counsellor;
- A copy of the most recently available Transcript of Marks.

The value of the Scholarship will be \$1,200.00.

The applications will be reviewed and a recipient selected by the Honours & Awards Committee of the Air Cadet League of Canada, Ontario Provincial Committee, whose decision is final.

Award of the Scholarship will not receive final approval until confirmation of proof of acceptance and registration at a university or college has been received. (Such proof is not required upon application).

The successful applicant will be announced on the OPC web site in July and a representative of the Wong Family will present the recipient with their scholarship at the Cadet Awards Luncheon of the OPC Annual Conference each fall. (The actual funds can be advanced earlier, if necessary).

Completed applications must be received at the OPC Office not later than 1 June.
