Air Cadet League Volunteer Service Medal



Eligibility for the Air Cadet League Volunteer Service Medal now includes;

Civilian Volunteers holding Squadron staff appointments and unpaid Civilian Instructors; in addition to, SSC members and Directors with 10 years' unpaid service.

Since the introduction of the Volunteer Service Medal in 2008, it was intended as an award for registered & screened individuals who are National, Provincial or SSC members, or Civilian Volunteers acting in support of the OPC or Squadron Sponsoring Committees.

At the National AGM in June 2018, the eligibility criteria were changed, and the OPC now accepts applications for the Medal, which include the following volunteer service:

- 1. **As Civilian Volunteers**: Registered & Screened individuals who have Staff duties at a Squadron, in addition to those who work in support of the SSC.
- 2. **As Civilian Instructors (Specialist or Generalist)**: Registered & Screened individuals holding CI status with DND on a Squadron's establishment who are unpaid.

Each additional ten years' service beyond qualification for the Medal, earns a silver or gold bar to place on the ribbon.
